

### Privacy Policy

PPO collects personal information as required to register and insure your child in our program. This includes your child's name, parent contact information, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, and date of birth. We might need to share this information with various leagues or entities so your child may be able to participate. Collected information may be shared with the City of Pembroke Pines. Beyond this, PPO does not sell or share your information with any outside organization that is not pertinent to running our program, or having your child involved in activities you are registering for.

### Refund Policy

**For competitive (Heat Strikers) teams:** Any and all fees collected by PPO are NOT refundable for ANY reason once they are received by PPO. Details and further stipulations are spelled out in your Player Agreement and Contract. Refunds will NOT be issued for internal transfers to the recreational program.

### Photo/Video/Audio/Correspondence Consent Agreement

I, being the parent/legal guardian of the player named on the reverse side of this form, hereby consent to the use of photos, video, or audio recordings of myself or of my child, including (but not limited to) print, audio, video and web promotion. Such materials may be posted to PPO's website or social media pages, or any other related websites, or used and reproduced in printed materials. I waive all claims to compensation or damages based on the use of my or my child's image, correspondence, or voice, and I also waive the right to inspect or approve the finished product. I understand that this consent is perpetual, that I may not revoke it, and that it is binding.

### Parents/Spectators Code of Ethics & Agreement to Follow

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, game officials, and administrators at all times.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of all players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will support the coaches, officials, and administrators working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will remember that the game is for the players, not for the adults.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, game officials, administrators, and fans with respect.
- I will always be positive.
- I will always allow the coach to be the only coach.
- I will not get into arguments with the opposing team's parents, players, or coaches.
- I will not come onto the field for any reason during the game.
- I will not criticize game officials.

- Alcohol, illegal drugs, and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed, or distributed before, during or after any game or at any other time at the field and/or game complex.

I agree to abide by and follow the Pembroke Pines Optimist Club's soccer program code of ethics. I also understand that my child, as well as all spectators coming to support my child, must also abide by and follow the code of ethics. I understand that any violation of the code of ethics may result in the expulsion of my child/children and myself from the Pembroke Pines Optimist Soccer program. I also understand that should my child/children be expelled, that I am not entitled to nor will receive a refund from the Pembroke Pines Soccer program, or the Pembroke Pines Optimist club, or any other entity.
