### Notes:

- Sean Farrell claimed sole possession of the highest scoring season in Chicago Steel history with a goal and a helper on Friday night. The Harvard University commit and Montreal Canadiens prospect passed Andrew Miller (Steel 2007-2009) who registered 82 points (32G, 50A) during the 2008-2009 campaign for the top spot on the Steel all-time list. Farrell now has 84 points (26G, 58A) through 45 games played this season.
- The Steel fell 5-4 to the Dubuque Fighting Saints on Friday night at Fox Valley Ice Arena, snapping a five-game streak in which the Steel had earned at least a point ... Neither team could reach the back of the net on the man advantage as the Steel went 1-for-1 (100%) on the penalty kill but registered an 0-for-4 (0.0%) night on the power play ... Chicago was outshot 34-23 in the loss ... Dubuque held the Steel off the scoreboard in the middle frame, just the fifth game this season Chicago had not reached the back of the net during the second period.
- **Jack Harvey** netted his eighth goal of the season, a marker that unleashed a wave of stuffed animals onto the ice for Teddy Bear Toss, presented by Geneva Family Dental.
- **Erik Middendorf** netted his 28th goal of the season, the second-most among all USHL skaters this season.
- Steel rookie **Adam Fantilli** added his 13th marker of the year, his third consecutive game with at least one tally.
- Jake Livanavage, Josh Doan, Dawson Pasternak, Jack Bar, Matt Coronato and Sam Lipkin each registered assists in the loss.

• Netminder **Jack Stark** made 29 saves, suffering just his third loss of the 2020-2021 campaign. The Yale University commit is now 9-3-0-0 between the Steel pipes.
