EAST COACHES



STEVE DROBOT graduated from Muskego High School in 2004 where he played soccer, basketball, rugby, and baseball in high school. His teams won three rugby state titles in his time at Muskego and was the captain of the 2004 State Championship team. He graduated college from UW Whitewater in 2009. He continued his rugby career at UW-Whitewater and student taught and played rugby in Melbourne, Australia.

He started coaching baseball as an assistant coach at Muskego High School in 2005. He coached freshman and JV teams at Muskego under coaches Mike Schramek and Jacob Paige until 2012 when he joined legendary Coach Hughes as a varsity assistant at Franklin. He has been teaching at Franklin High School as a Physical Education and Health Teacher since 2009. His parents also taught at Franklin High School. "There has been a Drobot teaching at Franklin since 1974," he said. "My dad Paul Drobot was a gymnastics and diving coach while teaching in the science department. My mom taught for over 30 years at Franklin in the business department.

"I took over as the head coach at Franklin High School in 2020 and my first year was the cancelled Covid Season," he said. It was a tough beginning to his head coaching career. This was technically his 4th season as head coach but he has only coached the Sabers for three full seasons.

The late start didn't slow down the winning in Franklin. In his first three seasons as a head coach, they won the Southeast Conference title three straight years and took his team to the Sectional finalists in back to back to back seasons, winning it this year and headed to State as we go to press. His, overall record to date is 69-9. "I take tremendous pride in not only developing strong baseball players but young men with strong character."



GREG FETHERSTON has had a storied career as the head baseball coach at Jefferson and the beat went on as he led his Eagles back to State for the third consecutive years. He began his career as an assistant at Jefferson for five years before taking over as head coach, a position he's had for the past 21 years. He has career coaching record of 367-150 and has been named the Southern Lakes twice in the Southern Lakes and seven times in the Rock Valley. He was the WBCA's State Coach of the Year in 2014. His teams have won 10 conference titles and 12 sectional titles. The Eagles were State Champs in 2014 and State Runners-Up in 2018, 2021, and 2022. Additionally, he has been the Summer Legion General Manager for 15 years, the Junior Eagle program Coordinator for 15 years and was an assistant coach for Team Serbia for four years. He has been a Field Director for the Milwaukee Brewer Baseball Academy for seven years and a co-representative for the Rock Valley Conference for over a decade. His wife Heather of 26 years and he have three children together.



NATHAN MEYER has been coaching at his alma mater, Union Grove, for the past 11 years. He graduated from UW-Whitewater and after assisting Bronco head coach Josh Pye for five years, He was hired as the head coach of the Broncos when Pye stepped away following the 2017 season.

Those worried about the program taking a step back shouldn't have been. It arguably has gotten even better. Meyer led the Broncos to a State Silver trophy in DII in 2019. This season, he picked up his 100th career victory in late May and guided his team to a ranking of 3rd in the final WBCA-PBR coaches poll. His Broncos were knocked out by rival Burlington in the Oregon Sectional final. Still, his head coaching career is off to a terrific start as he completes the 2023 season with a 104-26 (.800) career record. His teams have won three Conference titles, three Regional titles and three Sectional titles, in addition to being State Runner-up once.

A player's head coach is required to be a WBCA head coach for him to be invited to play in the All-Star Classic. Additionally, he has to accept the offer and raise a minimum amount of sponsorships to participate.
