-We are running the new coaching program for this year; we will be doing Tuesday/Thursday all levels will be practicing together as a large group, no split a or b teams. Working on station drills for the first few months to help with development and get them ready for the tryouts.

-Looking to higher a bantam coach this year. With a large team this year we will need to have an outside coach to run this team. We had two coaches apply for the job, but YHC does not think they are the best candidates. \$975.00 total cost for the coach. Motion to approve the option to pay for a head coach at the bantam level by Chase and second by Caleb.

-Bantam level family is asking to be released to the Ozaukee association. He will need to make the A team and accepted by Ozaukee first. If the kid does not make the A Team in Ozaukee he will need to return the SBLA and play with us. We will see what happens before a release will be granted.

-We need to figure out the financials for this year. We need a drop-dead date for final registrations fees. Also need to let them know of the refund policy if the season gets cut short. No team refunds for

sickness or team cancelations. If the association gets shut down then we will issue refunds accordingly pro-rate etc. motion to approve Caleb, second by chase. Before they tryout we will need to collect 2/3rds of the payment. Final payment will be collected mid November.
