

Guidelines for team bibs for MHSSC teams

1. The most important consideration: **the numbers on the bib need to be clearly visible.**
 - a. There should be high contrast between the numbers and the background color. So, it should be a light-colored numeral on a dark background or vice versa.
 - b. Bibs that incorporate an elaborate background design/pattern can make it difficult to see the numbers. These types of backgrounds/designs should be avoided.
 - c. In addition to the numbers on the bib, the **school/team name** should also have good contrast and be visible.
2. **Numeral size:** An experienced vendor of ski bibs should be able to assist with the design and ensuring that the numbers are standard size.
 - a. In general, each numeral should be a minimum of roughly 4 inches tall and roughly 3 inches wide.
3. **Bib numbers:** Please contact MHSSC leaders to inquire about what bib numbers your school/team has assigned to you. Likewise, please reach out if you need additional bib numbers because you're adding teams. Do not pick numbers without consulting the conference.
4. **Sponsors:** Teams may receive sponsorship from a local company and display that sponsorship/logo on their bib. If this is the case, the coach must share the mockup of the bib with MHSSC leaders to receive approval.
