

Hempfield Youth Football and Cheerleading Visiting Team Guidelines

The following guidance is being provided for participation and attendance of Hempfield Youth Football home games. Please review the following guidelines and communicate this information to your parents. We expect the visiting directors, teams and spectators to adhere to these guidelines. Thanks in advance for your understanding and cooperation!

- Games will be held at Hempfield High School – 200 Stanley Avenue, Landisville.
- Spectators are to be limited to immediate family only to allow for adherence to the mandated gathering limit of 250 people.
- We ask that everyone (directors, coaches, players, spectators) self-monitors 30 minutes (temperature and symptom check) before arriving at all games. If anyone is showing symptoms of COVID-19, please do not attend the game.
- All visiting teams and parents are asked to use the high school parking lot located at the corner of Kauffman Road and Mumma Drive, adjacent to the High School tennis courts and are to enter the stadium gate adjacent to the away ticket booth (see attached map).
- Away teams are to use the practice field adjacent to the parking lot for pre-game warmups (see attached map).
- Head coaches (or other representative) are to take the temperatures of their own team prior to entering the stadium. Documentation that temperature checks were performed should be retained by the away team. If a player has a temperature of 100.4 the player may sit in the shade for 30 minutes and have their temperature taken again. If the player still has a temperature, we will kindly ask the player to go home. Please make sure that parents are aware of this potential and are available in the event this occurs.
- Seating in the stadium should be within family groups and social distancing should be practiced from other family groups.
- Masks are to be worn at all times when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- We are asking all players, coaches and spectators to exit the stadium as soon as their game is over. Post game team talks are to be held outside the stadium. There will be a 15-20 minute break between games in order for this to happen.
- Spectators for the following games may not enter the stadium until it is cleared from the previous game. We will have volunteers at each gate to let attendees know when it is time to enter. Spectators will have plenty of time to enter the stadium and will not miss their players' game.
- Although we will have volunteers at both the home and away gates to assist in the communication process, it is the visiting director's responsibility to remind spectators to exit the stadium after games are over, and not allow the spectators for the following games to enter the stadium until it is cleared from the previous game. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in closing the stadium to spectators. If wanted, we would welcome a volunteer from the away team to assist our volunteer at the away gate.
- Limited concessions may be available.
