Meeting was called to order at 9:20pm.

- Marlyce discussed thoughts regarding the State Developmental Camp again this summer. Two sessions, one for the invited athletes, the second as a fundraiser for Janie Murakovskaya. Dates were discussed, leotards were discussed. MSGA will be the host – clinic tentatively scheduled for July 10.
- Michele reviewed the 2021-2022 State Championships. Early discussion regarding combining Levels 4-5-6 into one weekend based upon numbers of athletes. Will continue to compete XG and XS in one weekend (no longer have districts). Discussion regarding a three full gym set up at Shriners so we could go back to back weekends as in the past without an additional set up /breakdown. Michele will discuss a new drawing with Adam from DGS in the near future.
- Entry deadlines were discussed and everyone agreed that we could back them up a week. Therefore, qualification would be three weeks prior to each state meet in an effort to be able to get the information out sooner. Late entries continue to be an issue especially in the larger meets at the end of the season (even with reminders), hoping that one week earlier adds enough of a buffer to be able to track down late clubs before the final schedules are completed.

- Theme meets (and ability to request an increase in entry fees) will be discussed and revisited after the Regional Committee Meeting in June.
- Revisited the assigning process for the 2022-23 season as stated in the 9/24/21 meeting minutes. Long discussion took place regarding the role of NAWGJ in the 2021-2022 season. Deb recused herself from the vote.
 - For the 2022-2023 season, USA Gymnastics-Massachusetts will hire an independent assignor and will not be utilizing NAWGJ-MA for the service of assigning the MA State Qualifying Calendar nor for competitions under the jurisdiction of USAG-MA.
