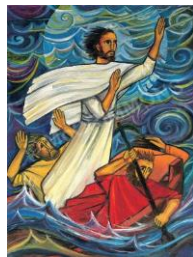

**Saint of the Week:** St. Thomas More

St. Thomas More was an English married man with four children, and the Chancellor to Henry VIII. Henry separated himself from the Catholic Church because he wanted to divorce his wife to marry another and got all the bishops of England — except for St. John Fisher whose feast we celebrate with St. Thomas on June 22 — to leave the Catholic Church and set up a separate Church in England. St. Thomas refused to support the King's behavior, and spoke against his unlawful divorce and remarriage. Because of that, St. Thomas was martyred on July 6, 1535, in the Tower of London. He left us an example how to respond to unjust civil laws, and a reminder to follow our well-formed consciences even when it is unpopular.
