1. Minutes

The minutes of the December were approved.

2. Treasurer's Report

A copy of the treasurer's report was handed out.

All basketball fees should be sent to Mike before the February meeting. Basketball fees should include the money for the tournaments. The state and city tournaments are \$150 per team.

There should be some excess funds available this year to help the athletic program at your school. Mike handed out the grant guidelines. After talking to your principal and athletic director it is determined that your school is interested in applying for grant money, you will need to complete the application and return it to Steve Haynes. Mike will know the amount available at the next CGSAA meeting.

5. **Soccer**

The rule changes were approved. Seventh and eighth grade games will be on a smaller field and will be eight on eight. There will be an occasional Thursday evening game. This will allow time for a soccer tournament at the end of the season and help with rain days.

Keiffer will be a member of the soccer board for the Optimists after January 23. Hopefully this will give the CGSAA more of a voice in decisions that are made by the board.

6. **Volleyball**

When you have your volleyball signup, do not forget to include boys. Boy teams will be able to play next year if they play one grade up. Eighth grade boys will play in the eighth grade league, but will not be able to hit or block in front of the 10-foot line. Beth will send out rules for the boys' teams.

Keiffer and Beth will try to coordinate the schedule so kids will be able to play both soccer and volleyball. Make sure to let Keiffer and Beth know if your team is comprised of soccer and volleyball players.

Eighth grade boys will have a tournament at the end of the year and will participate in a Casady tournament.

Either the club team scoresheet or the OSSAA scoresheet may be used at your gym.

7. **Track**

Johnny Kitchen proposed having a CGSAA 7th and 8th grade track team. The team would participate in several meets and train on seven different dates at different venues. The team would be for all interested 7th and 8th graders in a CGSAA school. Two of the meets will be on school days. Talk to your principal about having meets on a school day. The principals will meet later this month to discuss the issue.

The schedule of events for the CGSAA Meet will be on line. Johnny will send out a tentative schedule for practices at McGuinness. Let him know if the dates your school is assigned work for you.

The CGSAA meet will be on April 13.

The entry fee for this tournament is \$150 per team. Let Steve know if you have a team who will **NOT** be entering the tournaments.

Remind your coaches that if a team has two forfeits, they will not be able to play in the end of year tournaments.

Please bring the traveling trophy for the fourth graders to the next meeting.

Make sure you also send a note if there is a forfeit and if there are any technical fouls.
