Play begins promptly at 8:00 AM

Please provide your own balls for warmup and competition; Volleyball Lite will be used for the 12's tournament. **The 12's will have an optional second serving line moved in 7 feet from the end line.** This is a NCR required distance. Foot faults should be called if a player steps over this line.

Concessions will be available on site. T-shirts are for sale at the high school both days

Warm ups: Teams that are officiating should begin timing the warmups right away. Warm ups for the first two matches are 10 min (4-4-2) and 5 min (2-2-1) for all remaining matches

Pool play: 2 sets to 25 (no cap, win by 2)

Pool standings will be determined by:

1. Won/Loss record
2. Head to head results
3. Head to head point differential between tied teams
4. Total point differential
5. Coin flip

Playoffs: Single elimination with matches being 2 out of 3 sets. 3rd set if needed to 15. No cap win by 2.

Officiating: For the 12's and 14's, the coach must be the R1. For the 16's and 17's/18's, the coach can be either the R1 or R2. Please have your teams ready to officiate so the tournament can run in a timely manner.

- no use of cell phones while officiating or keeping score
- only players and coaches at scorer's table

Awards: Awards will be given for 1st and 2nd place in Gold and Silver.
