Coaches of the second game are to bring their players FAR away from the playing field to warm up and practice. They are not to go to the playing field until the previous game is over and the field is cleared. Parents and spectators for the second game are also expected to follow the same rules, they may not enter the game field area until the previous game is completed and the field is cleared.

		<p>*Full season schedule regardless of what school districts do unless the governor shuts it down.</p> <p>*Each team is to have a designated COVID person to run the safety checks on each player and to report to the one designated person of ZYFA who will report to the other communities/leagues. Tommy to be designated COVID person.</p> <p>-If a player has secondary exposure...the parent must bring the player in for a COVID test. If the parent doesn't want to do the test then the player is required to sit out for the 14 day period. If you are experiencing any symptoms even if for a day, you will be required to get tested. If you answer yes to any of the questions on the waiver then you are required to test. If there is a positive test... the whole team is shut down until tested.</p> <p>*What if we play a team and they end up having an exposure??? Move forward and play until someone shows symptoms.</p> <p>Waiver should state that rules are subject to change. The waiver should also state that ZYFA is NOT responsible for any injuries and/or illness during the football season.</p>
