Assessing for a Higher Age Group:

Players are placed in teams within their age bracket, based on their age as of January 1st.

A player is able to assess for possible inclusion in the next age division.

When a player assess for the next age division it is not a guarantee that she will be moved up.

The following factors must be considered before a player is moved up a division:

1. Space - is there space for additional players in the older age division.
2. Assessments - Division coaches and Board Members will assess each player's skill level as compared to other players in that age division. Any player deemed to be a risk playing a higher level, will not move up.

The WGS Boards asks the parents and players to understand these conditions and trust the Boards final decision based on what is best for the player and overall league.
