- The Steel fell 2-1 in overtime against the Dubuque Fighting Saints on Sunday afternoon at Mystique Community Ice Center in Iowa ... The Steel could not capitalize on the power play for just the second time this season, going 0-for-4 (0.0%) with the man advantage ... Chicago did not face any shorthanded time for the first time this year ... Both teams registered 24 shots on goal in the game.
- Chicago extended its point streak to 11 games in a row earning a point in the standings.
- Matt Coronato extended his USHL leading total to 32 points (14G, 18A) with a goal in the overtime loss. The Harvard-bound forward has reached the scoresheet in all 15 games for Chicago this season.
- **Erik Middendorf** extended his point streak to 15 games with his 13th helper of the season. The Chicago captain shares second in the USHL with 24 points (11G, 13A) this season.
- Forward **Sean Farrell** picked up a helper, pushing his current point streak to 11 games (6G, 13A). His 24 points this season (9G, 15A) share second in the league with **Middendorf**.
- Defenseman **Ryan Ufko** led the team with five shots on goal, his career best.
- Goaltender Ian Shane made 22 saves in the overtime loss, matching his season best with just two goals allowed.
