- **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**
 - R. Krause motioned to approve the November meeting minutes as submitted.

 - Full annual financial report will be distributed next week.
- **Registration Report** - *None*
- **League Commissioner Reports** –
 - Boys Tournament Teams (Rob) – Had a coach approach him requesting the allowance of two scrimmages.
 - R. Krause motioned to revise the GYS Tournament Team policy and procedures to allow tournament teams with one scrimmage in addition to the GYS Spring Training Day.
 - R. Ventgen seconded motion. Motion approved by all. Policies and procedures will be revised.

OLD BUSINESS/Discussion/Voting Items

- Security Fence work – Ryan Krause
 - Ryan met with Security Fence and Griesbach. Original proposal was to run poles down the center, but cannot do this because there is power running down the middle of the batting cage. Quote is now at: \$9,200 (black) or \$7,700 (galvanized) for complete restructuring of the Batting Cage A. The extra pad for the hitting nets on the side of the batting cage would be \$2,092 (galvanized poles – only) or \$2,575 (black). For batting cage D: \$1,997 (galvanized). For concrete bases of hitting nets \$9,000. Would cut asphalt and fill in around the poles. Not included in the costs are the turf, nets and cable.
 - If we proceed with this Ryan will have all of the poles down and ready for this in the next two weeks.
 - Will not get done this year, but hope to have it complete prior to April 1.
- Community Park improvements – Ryan Gass said that the committee is expecting a first look at the plan at their next meeting in two weeks.

- SportsEngine Update – Dave Much
 - The site is up in demo mode. Reporting and financials are working. Working on building out the form for background checks. Cost is \$20/coach. Player registration is done. Working on coaches registration.
 - Dave has pulled all the team rosters from last year.
 - Is there anything else we need from the old site. Once we pull the site we will no longer be able to access Jevin.
 - Planning to cut over to SportsEngine Jan. 1.

NEW BUSINESS/Discussion/Voting Items

- John O’Sullivan – Changing the Game (Darin Triplett)
 - Darin reached out to John O’Sullivan and received a quote of \$4,000 for three meetings/presentations.
 - At this time this would be a big financial commitment for our organization. We are open to continue looking at this with buy-in from other organizations so we can share the cost on this.
 - We do have the fieldhouse reserved the whole weekend of 7U and 8U boys tryouts and could host a coaching clinic (with the intent to teach skills and drills) – March 14-15 (all day Saturday and until 3:00 p.m. on Sunday) Maybe a coaching clinic from 12:00-3:00.
 - Website coordinators discussed building a website page specifically for coaches with a variety of resources for coaches. Mike L. mentioned that USA Baseball has an app with a lot of good drill videos which could be a great resource for coaches. As the website is being built we’ll continue to build this page.

- Darin, Angie and Ryan attended the Civic Club party last week and we were awarded \$2,000 for our help with Fright Night.
