



## **Apex Center Ice Arena**

**August 6, 2020**

### **Operational Rules and Guidelines**

- The two rinks will be staggered by 30-minute intervals to avoid any crossover of skaters in the locker rooms and lobby areas.
- Locker Rooms will be available for hockey players, with a maximum of 5 people per room. If additional space is needed, chairs around the perimeter of the rink will be used. Shower areas in the locker rooms will remain closed. Skaters are encouraged to come dressed.
- Spectators are not allowed in the facility.
- Parents of Squirts and Mites will be allowed in the building to assist players tie their skates. They will also be allowed back in the building when the session has ended to assist with removing skates/gear. Parents and players will be allowed to enter ten minutes prior to a session and must leave within ten minutes after a session ending.
- Skaters, chaperones, and instructors agree to stay home if they believe that they may be symptomatic or may have come in contact with someone who may have COVID 19.
- All staff, instructors, skaters, and chaperones are required to wear masks while in the facility. Masks are strongly recommended for skaters while training on the ice surface.
- All staff, instructors, skaters, and chaperones will be required to have temperatures taken upon entering the facility.
- Safe, six-foot distancing must be maintained on the ice and in the lobby area.
- One male and one female bathroom in the lobby will be open.
- Skaters will need to bring their own water bottles. The bottle-fill feature on the water fountain will be available for use.
- There will be thirty-minute breaks between sessions to allow for staff to disinfect areas that have been occupied.

### **Cleaning and Disinfecting**

- The top of the dasher boards will be cleaned with disinfectant hourly, after each session.
- Hand Sanitizer will be readily available in the lobby and each locker room.
- There will be a designated employee who will continuously monitor and clean the high-traffic areas, cleaning a minimum of an hourly basis.
  - All cleaning staff will be required to wear PPE.
  - Door handles, hand-rails, benches, walls, and any "touch" areas will be consistently wiped down with disinfectant.
