Game Day COVID Procedures

*updated 10/1/2020

- No spectators are allowed
- Players, Coaches, Parents and Volunteers agree to stay home if they believe that they may be symptomatic or may have come in contact with someone who may have COVID-19
- Temperatures will be taken upon entering the facility
- All Apex visitors must wear facemasks and maintain appropriate social distancing at all times
- Teams will be allowed in the facility 15-30 minutes prior to game time depending on locker room availability – Apex staff will do their best to allow access as early as possible
- Teams may use the grass area and driveway adjacent to the ice arena for pre-game warmups
- Each team may have no more than 4 coaches/staff on their bench
- Home team may provide 3 game workers – Clock, Score Keeper, Penalty Box
- Visiting team may provide 1 game worker – Penalty Box
- 1 parent per team will be allowed to livestream the game from the designated area in the stands
- Players are required to wear facemasks in the facility including locker rooms.
- Players are not required to wear facemasks on the bench or on the ice
- Coaches/staff are required to wear facemasks at all times including on the bench
- Locker Room bathrooms and showers are not available at this time
- Locker Room doors are to remain open to allow for proper air circulation
- One male and one female bathroom is available in the lobby
- Players must bring their own water bottles - the bottle-fill filler on the lobby water fountain is available for use
- Players, coaches and game workers should leave the building quickly following the game so Apex staff can clean and prepare for the next game
