VP Fundraising: Connie – 2 more fundraisers this year: scheduled to happen April 29 before Mother's Day at Kendra Scott; Whataburger Spirit Night following a Varsity baseball game TBA.

Coaches' Reports:

Basketball – made playoffs, lost by 2. Best season we've had in 20 years: 24 wins (11 district); First Team All-District, two players made Second Team All-District and two players named to All-District Honorable mention and Coach Brayton named co-coach of the year;

Softball – 10-7-1 2/2 in District; playing well with 2 big games this week; district-wide everyone is chasing Katy; half-game behind Mayde Creek who we play this week trying to make top 4 spots.

Track – Three Varsity meets with girls setting three records and boys closing in on breaking some records before the end of the season.

Boys soccer – beat Mayde Creek; we tend to be a stronger second-half season; plays Jordan tomorrow at Rhodes.

Bowling – not a UIL sport; both boys and girls qualified for State
