

SOUTH DAVIS RECREATION CENTER

The South Davis Recreation Center facility has not released a formal document on COVID regulations as of August 23, 2020. However, their website indicates the general guidelines that we will adhere to as a user of the facility. Additionally, the SDRC Hockey Director has identified specific guidelines for the rink. When the Eagles teams and fans comply with these measures it insures our continued use of the rink. Let's work together to be compliant and keep this season going. All guidelines are subject to change at any time. Please note that regulations vary from group to group that is using the facility. If one group's privileges seem more liberal than another then they likely are different. The Eagles enter written or verbal agreements with the local rinks that are separate than the guidelines for other organizations or public session. The Eagles will we aim to be compliant regardless of what other groups are doing.

All patrons entering the building must wear a face-covering.

There is a limit of one parent per player in the SDRC rink and facility for all Eagles practices, scrimmages, events and games. Ask your team manager for guidance on the parent with minor children.

Helping your 12U player to tie skates is allowed, in the lobby only. The parent must exit the facility immediately after finishing the skate tying. If this is the only parent with the player for that instance, they become the one spectator/parent per player and they should proceed to the stands. No congregating in the lobby. This season all children must be seated with their parents/adult. No playing anywhere in the facility. Bring seated activities for minor children.

No congregating in the lobby. No standing by the lobby glass to observe rink activities. Plan accordingly with a warm jacket and/or blanket. Be prepared to go directly to your car after the players leave the ice. The lobby congregation guideline may change with weather conditions.

Your team manager is responsible for sanitizing all the areas where your team players and fans have been while in the facility. For this reason, if the team manager cannot recruit the volunteers to conduct required sanitizing of the locker rooms, benches, scorers' box, railings in the stands, lobby table, etc. then he/she may choose to exercise the "no spectator" rule. Please help out as much as you can.

All patrons, while in the building, shall adhere to the 6-foot social distancing guideline. This includes all areas of the facility.

Please do not congregate near the glass overlook located on the mezzanine level. Rather, when spectators are allowed, please use the rink stands area. This reduces the manpower needed to sanitize all the locations where Eagles parents and fans have been.

Only authorized persons will be allowed to livestream activities at the SDRC rink. No one is to self-elect themselves as the team videographer or camera person. Those persons will be determined by the Eagles Committee in consultation with the team manager. Please approach your team manager and request to be this person if that interests you. This person may be rotated throughout the season.

Capacity numbers are affected by the persons in the scorers' box, penalty box, locker room monitors, team manager. The team does not get more spectator spots due to needing these roles to be filled.

This will be a tough year for all. Be kind to your team manager, he/she did not make up these regulations but must enforce them. These guidelines are a combination of local, state, CDC, facility and Eagles requirements and comfort level. If you take exception to these guidelines, please offer alternate suggestions. We are all in this together and we need collective problem-solving to make it through this season.
