# Surrounding Town Participation

We are committed to providing opportunities for boys and girls in grades K-8 to participate in youth lacrosse. As our program continues to grow, we want to ensure that we can accommodate all participants while maintaining a high-quality experience. The following policy outlines our guidelines for accepting players from surrounding towns that do not have their own youth lacrosse programs.

**1. Priority:**

- Priority for registration is given to residents of Branford.
- Players from other towns without a lacrosse program will be accepted only if space allows.

**2. Timeline:**

- Players from surrounding towns without a lacrosse program are eligible to register only during the last two weeks of the registration period and only for teams that still have remaining space.

**3. Capacity:**

- Due to the growing size of our program, we reserve the right to cap the number of participants to ensure safety, coaching quality, and a positive experience for both players and coaches.
- Program capacity is evaluated annually, and adjustments may be made to accommodate changes in interest or staffing.

**4. Fees:**

- Once paid, all registration fees are non-refundable.
