Attached are two reports for your review:

- Alaska Registration Summary
- Alaska Players by Age per Association

The first report details the breakdown by player, coach, manager, volunteer and unclaimed for your association.

The second report breaks down the player registration by Age Classification in your association.

As reported in January 2018, based on December 2017 reports, player participation was down in every age category, and that is still the case. That is still the case with these reports, with most significant decline at the 9 & 10 age level (Squirts).

Spring and summer tournaments have begun! If there is a team traveling outside to participate in any summer tournament (USA Hockey Sanctioned or Not), they must be registered through a local association program and have a USA Hockey Sanctioned 1T. If you have a coach that coaches in your association during the regular season, and he/she is planning to go outside for a tournament, please ensure the team is registered. Once that is done, and I know what tournament they are traveling too, I can advise if they need a travel permit or not. If a tournament is not USA Hockey Sanctioned, I strongly encourage that the team procures a sports tournament insurance policy or at the very least has all parents sign waiver of liability forms. *The requirement of a 1T is a rule in the ASHA Handbook.*

Several coaches received 2017.18 temporary coaching cards during the regular season. Please be advised that in order for them to be put on 2018.19 1T's that they must have their CEP updated PRIOR to the start of the season.
