- Officer elections: 1 year terms
 - Kelly M. to remain secretary; Darren to remain treasurer
 - J. Howe to be VP
 - Matt Prucka to remain President
- Review of progression from Park City skating / hockey classes to PCIM
 - Saturday classes – better timing and better engagement from kids & parents
 - Better for schedule
 - Late spring 2024 – started trial of Saturday mini pucksters
 - 25ish kids each session
 - Way to get them into Basic Hockey / Learn to Play
 - Review of proposed guidelines for Hockey 1 / 2 / 3 / 4
 - Plan is for kids to be “graduates” of Hockey 4 before they come an Ice Miner
 - Re-brand to help process
 - Problem to be solved: to get everyone on similar skill level on 6U/8U program
 - Cost – no impact for us
 - Might lose 6U players
 - Numbers anticipated to be just as strong for next winter –
 - Always encouraged people to start with city classes
 - Rink to be base of pyramid – support user groups
 - Hockey 1/2/3 would take place of Basic Hockey Skating & Learn to Play
 - Is this a general concept we support?
 - General clarity to people on evaluations
 - Rec House numbers have always fluctuated – are we going to have Rec teams for every age group?
 - Not currently changing House teams with Ice Miners.
 - More families – consistently growing
 - Board general consensus to support City plan
- Communications: Jen Cornet – wants to help with communications, graphics, flyers
 - Reese family playing elsewhere

- Finances & upcoming budget
 - Current status of financials
 - Registration fees lower – no 16U travel team this year
 - Last year ran deficit of 17k; this year deficit 10k and may grow a bit
 - Balance sheet: 162k in the bank; that’s just a buffer
 - Been drawing it down the last few years
 - No liabilities; everything run on cash basis
 - Financially we are where we want to be; where we expected
 - Projected total team fee
 - Formula for cost & ice time for practice / games / tournaments
 - All based on cost to play
 - Coach cost – based on actual cost from last year
 - Tournament cost doesn’t include HMSO
 - Coaching increases on 12U A
 - Prucka idea: increase fees slightly at each level & create a pot for volunteer hours
 - Moving forward with this plan
 - Prucka will adjust season fees
 - Minor increase to compensate volunteers
 - Ashlei – tryout registration
 - 16 tier 25 skaters & 3 goalies
 - 14u (Tier) – 33
 - 10u - 42
 - 12u - 52 skaters & 6 goalies
 - Logistics
 - Coaches on the ice – 1 person on the ice & 1 person on each bench
 - Check in process – do we need more volunteers? Ashlei says no
 - Deadline for committing – May 8
 - Parent meeting – after 2nd skate on Sunday
 - 15-20 minutes
 - Yvette: 7am-1:30pm on Sunday for trying on uniforms
 - Will not be there Monday night
 - Par

 - Kelley volunteered to be Volunteer Coordinator
- Coaching vacancies
 - 10U B and 16 Travel coaching vacancies
 - Potential coaches reaching out to Adamek
- House teams
 - Going to be scheduled by UHC
 - Doubling cost of participation for teams
- High Mountain Shoot Out
 - November 7 weekend
 - To avoid Halloween
 - Would be great to have only Park City & Steiner as rinks
- Hockey Operations

 - Making plans for summer ice development – growing as summer goes on
