

Parent/Player Contract – 2020/2021

1. Practice is mandatory unless an athlete is involved in a school activity and has been excused to miss practice. Playing time certainly plays into the equation when athletes miss practice on a regular basis. To be able to participate in a tournament all athletes must be at the practice prior to competition unless they have a scheduled school activity that the coach has been made aware of at least one week in advance. We ask that you coordinate with your coach a time to make up your missed practice if possible. If the athlete misses the last practice before a tournament, for a non-school related activity, this must still be communicated in advance.

2. Participation in all tournaments is mandatory. If a player is unable to attend due to a scheduled sport or school event, they must notify their coach a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the event.

3. There is no such thing as "equal" playing time in volleyball. Volleyball is different from other sports in that it is not a timed game; there are no innings, no quarters or halves to base playing time. Due to the nature and speed of the game, you cannot judge "time" by rotations or points either. We understand all athletes practice so they can play in games. We strive to give all athletes "fair" playing time based on practice, ability, attendance, skills, positions, situations, etc.

Our coaches are open to speaking with the athletes and encourage this if they have concerns. If there are further concerns parents may contact the club directors via email for further follow up.

6. In the unfortunate event a player decides to leave the program early, the player is still responsible for all dues for the season with no guarantee of a refund. Pro-rated refunds will be made upon the approval of the directors under extenuating circumstances only and is on a case by case basis.
