# **NATIONAL SPORTS ID**

Each player will have to complete age verification through National Sports ID, as well as participant registration through SportsEngine. In order to complete your National Sports ID registration, you will be required to upload a 1) player headshot; 2) birth certificate or state ID; and 3) report card, school account, progress report or school ID. #### **3 & 4 GAME TOURNAMENT RULES**

# **Inclement Weather Policy**

In the event of rain we will do everything in our power to stay as close to the game schedule as possible. However, due to limited field availability, we may have to deviate from the printed schedule.

If we need to alter the schedule, we will use the following procedures/priorities as our guide:

- · Our first priority is always to make sure that each team plays its minimum number of games
  - We will try to maintain the original schedule as best we can
  - In the event of weather/time, it may not be possible to accommodate schedule requests
- · We will attempt to have a championship game
  - We may eliminate the quarter-final or semi-final round to ensure a championship game

Games that do not make it to regulation (4 complete innings [or 3.5 if the home team is winning] for a 6 inning game or 5 complete innings [or 4.5 if the home team is winning] for a 7 inning game) due to weather/darkness will be considered as suspended games and will resume (if possible) from the point of suspension at the earliest available time. If there is not enough time to resume a suspended game, it will be considered complete and official at the end of the last complete Inning.

# **Pool Play Games**

- If a game Is suspended prior to being official and there is not enough time to resume, the game will be considered complete at the end of the last complete inning
- · If tied at the end of the last complete inning, the game will stand as a tie

#### **Elimination Games**

- If one inning hasn't been completed, the game is suspended, and there is not enough time to resume, the higher seed will advance to the next round.
  - If tied at the end of the last complete inning, the higher seed will advance
  - If tied at the end of the last complete inning and the two teams are the same seed from different divisions entering the game, we will revert back to the tie-breaking system in place (least runs allowed)
- If the championship game starts and is not able to be completed due to weather/darkness, the game will be considered official at the end of the last complete Inning.
  - If tied at the end of the last complete inning, both teams will be named co-champions
- If one inning hasn't been completed in the championship game and the game is suspended, both teams will be named co-champions.

# **Lightning Policy**

- · When lightning approaches within 8-20 miles, staff will monitor the storm activity and prepare for possible suspension of games
- When lightning is detected within 8 miles, all games will be suspended. At that time, players, coaches and spectators should proceed to the safest possible place. All fields, batting cages, and training areas will be closed until the staff clears the complex for play
- · Games will resume once the lightning has moved outside of the 8 mile radius for a period of 15 minutes

#### **3 & 4 GAME TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE**

All 2-day weekend tournaments will have a 3 game minimum format (with the possibility of playing 5 games in the weekend) in which each team will play 2 games on Saturday and 1 on Sunday morning. The top seeds will then play in the championship bracket to determine the champion. All 3 day holiday weekend tournaments will have a 4 game minimum format (with the possibility of playing 6 total games) that will also consist of pool play games as well as single elimination games to determine a champion.

### **FACILITY INFORMATION**

### What to bring

Portable tents, chairs, and coolers are allowed inside the facility. We highly recommend visiting www. visitmyrtlebeach.com/things-to-do/beaches/ to learn more about beach safety. Due to COVID-19, we will not have bleachers available for seating, so we encourage our visitors to bring their own tents and chairs.

# **Parking**

There is plenty of **FREE** parking available for all visitors at The Ripken Experience Myrtle Beach. We are not responsible for any damaged vehicles or theft. Camper/RV parking is located in our overflow parking lot off of Mancini Drive. Please note that vehicles are not allowed to be left in the lot overnight.

### Admission

There will be **NO GATE FEE** at any of our events. We encourage family and friends to come to the complex to cheer on the athletes and show their support.

# **Guest Screening**

Daily self-evaluation guest screenings need to be completed by all guests prior to entering the facility. Please avoid travel if you are not feeling well. Guests experiencing COVID-19 syptoms while traveling should contact a local health are facility immediately.

# Big League Grill / Concessions

For your health safety, we have restricted access to our dining areas. However, our concession stands are open. We are happy to serve you through our convenient to-go windows where pre-packaged items such as nachos, sandwiches, and bottled beverages are available.

# Pro Shop / Merchandise

The Pro Shop will be closed for indoor shopping, but you will be able to purchase merchandise through our mobile ordering. All orders placed will be available within two (2) hours of ordering. We will also have our 'gameday essentials' window open for quick in-person purchases.

# **Pets**

With the exception of service animals, pets are not permitted at The Ripken Experience for liability reasons.

### First Aid / Certified Athletic Trainers

A First Aid responder will be on-site at The Ripken Experience (All full time staff are First Aid, AED, and CPR certified). It is important to remember that First Aid responders are not medical doctors. They provide basic first aid, determine the severity of injuries, and make recommendations as to whether or not a player should see a doctor or go to the emergency room.

### Weapons

Weapons of any type are strictly prohibited on the grounds. Anyone found to be in possession of weapons will be asked to leave the premises for the remainder of the tournament. The Ripken Experience reserves the right to contact local authorities if any weapons are suspected or seen on the premises.



### BASEBALL PROGRAMMING

### **Pre Tournament Practices**

For all weekend tournaments, batting cages and training island are on a first come first serve basis. The complex is open Friday from 10AM to 4PM. All fields will be closed and will not be available for rent on the Friday prior to the tournament. Health screenings will be checked upon entrace to the facility.

### Team Uniforms

Teams are required to bring and wear their own uniforms. Each player on a team should have a unique number displayed on their jersey.

### **Dress Code for Coaches**

Managers and coaches are not required to be in uniform during the games. However, we do expect the adults on the field to be dressed appropriately. As of 8/3/20, everyone is required to wear face coverings inside the complex per SC department of Admission (SCOA).

# Managers' Meeting

All managers and coaches are encouraged to view our online Managers' Meeting video prior to arrival, which addresses tournament rules, activities, and behavior expectations.

#### **Awards**

A team trophy and individual awards will be presented to the championship and runner-up teams. Also, a championship game medallion will be awarded for each age group within the tournament. The Ripken Experience staff will determine the championship game MVP.

### **Umpires**

All pool play and single elimination games will have 2 umpires, including the championship game. Certified umpires will be chosen from a professional organization. There will be an umpire behind the mound calling balls & strikes, while the second umpire will behind home plate calling fair & foul.

# Baseballs / Equipment

Game balls will be provided by The Ripken Experience for all games. Teams are to bring their own practice balls. All other baseball and safety equipment is the responsibility of each team. Each team will also be given one case of water and one case of gatorade per day upon checking into the facility.

#### No Alcohol or Tobacco Products

Absolutely no alcohol or tobacco products will be permitted inside The Ripken Experience complex. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in being asked to leave the property.

#### Game Balls

Foul balls that exit the field of play will be retrieved by the team batting and will then be placed in the designated bucket behind the press box at each field.
