

TEAM SELECTION PROCEDURE (updated January, 2024)

Thank you for agreeing to work on this year's All-Star Games selection committee. The job you do will have a tremendous impact on the overall success of the event.

To fill out the enclosed team roster you will need the following:

1. 2 pitchers per team
2 catchers per team
2 first base per team
2 second base per team
2 shortstop per team
2 third base per team
3 outfielders per team
1 utility player per team will probably fill outfield or no-show spot
1 director's choice per team needs to be a pitcher that can play somewhere else

2. If the state champion in any class has no senior all-starter, then the coach of the state champion may select one of their seniors to represent their team. Make sure we have quality people ahead of her. She is one of the seventeen.
3. If there are two girls from the same team participating in the all-star game, place them on the same team. **There can be no more than three players from any one high school.**
4. If an all-star team coach has an athlete playing, she should be on the same team. .
5. When talking to the athletes, **get as much information from them as possible.** Fill out the profile for each girl. Ask about academic awards, National Honor Society, plans for next year, outside interests, clubs, unusual experiences, future plans in softball etc. Every little bit helps when writing their resume' for the program.
