



WESTONKA YOUTH FOOTBALL (WYF) MANDATORY CODE OF CONDUCT



All players, coaches, and parents must sign the Westonka Youth Football (WYF) Code of Conduct prior to the start of the season. All participants in the WYF will be held responsible for their actions during league play. Coaches must read the following information to their coaches, players, and their parents prior to the start of the season.

1. I will not berate the referees or “trash talk” to my opponents!
2. I will not use profanity!
3. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, contest administrators and referees at every game.
4. I will place the emotional and physical well being of my teammates and opponents ahead of my personal desire to win.
5. I will treat other players, coaches, fans and umpires with respect regardless of race, gender, creed, or ability.
6. I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all WYF practices, scrimmages, games, and team functions.
7. I will do my best to remember that youth sports are supposed to be FUN and that winning and losing are part of everyone’s experience.
8. I will express my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified manner.
9. I will respect the volunteers who are assisting with the conduct of these events.
10. I will respect and adhere to the rules governing eligibility and competition.

PENALTY

Any violation of the WYF Code of Conduct may result in temporary or permanent banishment from any WYF sponsored events. PLEASE BEHAVE OR BE GONE - THANK YOU!
