

5/19/2021 Covid-19 Virus Update

Pond Athletic Association (PAA) will follow the recommendations set forth by the Center of Disease Control (CDC). The health and safety of players, coaches, and families are our highest priority. Anyone who is fully vaccinated is not required to wear a mask or be physically distant. Anyone who is not fully vaccinated should keep a mask on while at the facility unless they are actively eating or drinking. It will be each person's responsibility to do the right thing. Everyone is still encouraged to wear a mask if they choose. PAA will respect each person's choice.

Covid Requirements:

1. SPECTATORS – There will be no limit to the number of spectators allowed to each game if they follow social distancing guidelines or wear masks, according to CDC recommendations.
2. MASKS – Anyone who is fully vaccinated is not required to wear a mask or be physically distant. Anyone who is not fully vaccinated should keep a mask on while at the ballpark unless they are actively eating or drinking. It will be each person's responsibility to do the right thing.
3. SCREENING – At this time, we are discontinuing the screening process.
4. COACH LIMIT – At this time, there will be no limit to the number of coaches.
5. WATER – Players are encouraged to have their own water/drinks.
6. DUGOUTS – Teams are required to clean their dugout of all trash and other items after each game.
7. EQUIPMENT – Each player is strongly encouraged to have his/her own glove, helmet, and bat.
8. AFTER GAME – No handshakes after the game. Teams may line up in front of their dugout and wave to the other team.
