Notes:

- The Steel notched their first win of the season while handing the Green Bay Gamblers their first loss of the year with a 7-3 victory at Fox Valley Ice Arena on Friday night ... The Steel out-shot the Gamblers by a 35-28 margin and fought back from a 1-0 deficit with six consecutive goals ... Chicago went 1-for-4 (25%) with the man advantage while cancelling 3-of-4 penalties faced on the night.
- **Matt Coronato** scored two goals for the second-straight game and added an assist. He now has seven points (4G, 3A) in two games thus far, tied for the USHL lead.
- Steel captain **Erik Middendorf** recorded a multi-point night with a marker and one helper. **Middendorf** now has goals in back-to-back games.
- Forward **Mackie Samoskevich** notched his second-consecutive multi-assist game with a pair of helpers. The University of Michigan commit now has seven points (7A) in two games.
- **Matthew Gleason** tallied a goal in his season debut with the Steel.
- Forward **Jackson Blake** notched a marker for the second consecutive game and picked up an assist.
- **Adam Robbins** and **Anthony Dowd** each added helpers in the win.
- Netminder **Ian Shane** made 25 saves to earn his first victory of the season.
