Old Business

Registration

- With some minor updates, registration will open on Monday, August 16. An email will go out to the club.
- Board approved re-branding Initiation Program as Hockey 101.
- Board approved offering a "Practice Only" option on the registration. The fee will be 50% of the player's age level.
- Discussion was had regarding fees related to players who want to double roster and practice up. It was determined these fees had not been addressed for several years and needed to be adjusted due to the increased cost of ice as well as the additional ice time gained by players who are able to take advantage of these opportunities.
 - Board approved all players (male & female) who would like to double roster will pay \$200 in addition to their age level player fees. The Player Movement Policy will be updated accordingly.
 - Board approved the Practice-Up fee to be \$100. The Player Movement Policy will be updated accordingly
