

## **Guidelines for Youth Hockey Games**

For us to maintain everyone's safety, we need everyone to adhere to our revised guidelines. These are subject to change as we receive updated local and state mandates.

## ("Participant" refers to coaches, managers and/or players)

- All Participants are entering at will. By participating, everyone acknowledges they are feeling healthy, do not have a fever (temperature over 100.4 degrees) and can honestly answer "have not" to the CDC screening questions "Have you experienced: (1) COVID-19 symptoms in past 14 days, (2) positive COVID-19 test in past 14 days, and/or (3) close or proximate contact with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case in past 14 days."
- Each Participant may have no more than two spectators viewing the game.
- Participants may not arrive more than 15 minutes before their scheduled start time and <u>must enter</u> <u>through the Market Street entrance</u> (lower level). It may be easiest to drop your player at the door and then find a parking spot.
- Spectators may not arrive more than 5 minutes before the scheduled game start time, to allow enough time to get the previous users out and public areas sanitized.
- Everyone must wear a mask when entering and exiting the building.
- Everyone must use the hand sanitizer station prior to entering through the second doorway.
- Once in the building, you will be directed to the assigned locker room or designated spectator area.
- Spectator viewing areas will be at ice level, or in designated bleacher sections. All upstairs warming areas will not be open.
- Just prior to taking the ice, Participants may remove their masks and properly secure their helmets and exit the locker room.
- Spitting will not be tolerated anywhere within the facility. Teams will be fined \$50 per occurrence for spitting.
- Scorekeepers, clock attendants and coaches must wear a mask at all times. Please refrain from having a volunteer in the penalty box. Scorekeeper will need to assist with penalty boxes.
- As much as possible, everyone should maintain 6' social distancing on and off the ice.
- There are no shower facilities available for Participants or officials.
- After game is complete, Participants have 10 minutes to change, retrieve belongings and exit. Spectators must exit immediately after the game. No loitering within the arena, bleacher areas or lobby.
- When leaving rink area, everyone should again utilize the hand sanitizer station, then follow the directional arrows for exiting.
