



Boys and Girls HS Futsal League

General Information and Rules

The first matches will begin on **January 20, 2019**. Please check the site each week to see if your game is on court # 1 or # 2 and if you are the home or away team.

Location: All matches will take place at the Strike FC Futsal Facility located at:

**528 East Industrial Drive
Hartland, WI 53029**

Equipment:

- Strike FC will provide futsal balls for games.
- The home team will wear LIGHT colored uniforms.
- The away team will wear a DARK colored uniform.
- Players must have shin guards covered with socks and flat soled shoes.
- Outdoor cleats are not allowed in the facility.
- Players cannot play in the shoes they walk into the building with. This helps us avoid water spots on the futsal flooring and maintains a safe playing environment.

Players: Match play is 5v5 (4v4 +GK's) Players sub on fly. If an "advantage" is gained by this, a free kick will be awarded to the other team.

Referees: Each match will have a referee. The referees will keep time and score on the scoreboard and number of fouls per team. 6 fouls in one half will result in a penalty kick for the other team and each foul after in a half will also result in a penalty kick. Games will start at the posted time on our game schedule.

Duration of Game: 2 x 20 minute halves (running clock), 5 minute half-time.

Ball In and Out of Play: Pass-ins (foot) instead of throw-ins. Ball must be stopped completely on line. Opposing teams must be 5 yards back. Player must take pass-in within 4 seconds, or a turnover results giving possession to the other team.

Fouls: Direct free kicks are awarded when a player intentionally commits any of the following offenses:

- personal foul against opponent (kicking, grabbing, tripping, etc.)
- handball
- slide tackle

Indirect free kicks are awarded when any of the following offenses is committed:

- Dangerous play
- Obstruction
- Goalkeeper throws ball directly over the halfway-line
- Goalkeeper picks up or touches with his hands a pass from a teammate,
- Goalkeeper holds ball more than 4 seconds
- Unsportsmanlike conduct (dissent, foul language, etc.)

Goal Clearances: This is a goal kick in futsal. Goalie starts with ball in hand and may throw or place ball down to play with feet. Ball must be played out of the goal box to be in play and occur within four seconds of picking ball up.

Goalkeeper Usage: Unlimited goalkeeper usage within play. Goalkeeper must play the ball within four seconds or a kick in is awarded to the opposing team.

Rosters: Each team needs to complete a league roster form. The league is intended to help teams prepare for their HS seasons. Sharing of players between teams of the same school is permitted as a way to help teams cover in the event of players missing. The league operates under the principle, however, that teams do this in a sporting way and not to solely to gain a competitive advantage.

Standings: Standings will be tracked on our league website. Teams earn 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, and 0 points for a loss. In the case of teams being tied, the following tiebreakers will be used to determine league standing:

- Head to Head Results
- Goal Differential
- Goals For
- Goals Against

Awards: Players on the winning team of each girls flight (EPL, La Liga, and Serie A) and boys flight (JV, EPL, La Liga) will receive an award.

- Girls League and JV Boys League = Each team plays the other 7 teams in their division once. No playoff, winners based upon total points and tie breakers in the event of equal points.
- Boys Varsity League = Each team plays 6 rounds of play. Last date matches teams in EPL division against teams in La Liga division. First place EPL and La Liga teams win awards and play each other for League Championship.
