









Many games will be played during the hockey season, which runs approximately from September through late-February. Each Association determines their home game guidelines.

NMAHA game guidelines are as follows:

GameSheet TIPS for LOEAHA REC LEAGUE

- 1 Manager/Scorekeeper gets iPad (red case) and uploads the game(s) no more than 4 hours and no less than 30 minutes prior to the first game
- 2 Each iPad has a passcode - to sign in use the passcode specific to the iPad, found on a white sticker on the front of each iPad
NOTE: the game must be scored and completed from the device that it is uploaded on, you cannot change iPads once a game is loaded or during a game
- 3 Open the GameSheet app 
- 4 Sign in with the **LOEAHA REC League** Scoring Access Key: [ipad-loeaha-kw](#)
- 5 Upload game for scoring
The "Games" page is displayed - select "+New Game" from the middle of the page 
Select "Load from schedule" *a list of today's games will be displayed
Tap  then select the date and find the specific game to score - verify date, location and team
Tap the game to begin
- 6 Game Details - Do NOT make any changes to these settings
- 7 Home / Visitor Lineup - The Coach or Manager must select the lineup for the game
Eligible players will be listed as active - Managers should verify jersey numbers and update if necessary
Tap to select each player not playing in today's game and update their status **Suspensions MUST be indicated*
Select the starting Goalie by tapping on Goalie's name and marking *Starting*
Coach signs the lineup
- 8 Scoring - enter the actual game start time and select "start game"
- 9 If tracking shots, use  at the bottom of the page
NOTE: Only record shots that would go in the net if the goalie was not there (post, crossbar, blocks are NOT recorded as shot on goal)
- 10 Adding a goal - Make sure to select  under the appropriate team
Enter the time of goal
Enter the Player scoring goal
Tap in the first "A" box to enter the first assist, repeat in second box if Referee indicates a second assist
Select "Empty Net" if the goal is scored without a goalie in net
- 11 Adding a penalty - Make sure to select  under the appropriate team
Enter the time off ice and time on ice (they will be the same)
Enter the Duration - NOTE: for Biscuit League penalties are "PS" (penalty shot)
Enter the Penalty Code (if provided)
If the player scores on a penalty shot make sure to enter the goal for the appropriate team using the time of the penalty and the player scoring the goal
- 12 When the period ends - select the next period at the top middle of the page 
- 13 Continue until all periods are played
- 14 If a Shoot Out is necessary select the SO button next to the period indicator 
Designate the shooter and record the outcome for each attempt
- 15 When the game is over, verify there are no errors 
If the orange error button is displayed, click on it and follow the prompts to resolve the error
If the white warning button is displayed, click on it to review - it does not need resolved to complete the game
- 16 Click 
- 17 Give the iPad to the Official to add themselves to the game by tapping "Add Referee"
The Referee will review the penalties and confirm accuracy or edit if necessary, add notes to major and misconduct penalties and **SIGN**
The Referee will lock the game and return the iPad
- 18 The Games screen will display a blue icon  to the right of the game, tap it to upload the game
The game will disappear and a scoresheet will be sent to coaches/managers via email
- 19 Log out of scoring app
