**Executive Director - Frank Salvoni** - It's the last week of practice! Frank thanked the board for supporting him through his first full season. The IAHA Midget State tournament is this coming weekend at Hailey Ice and SV Rink. We still have teams traveling to the Spring Fling and the HS Varsity team will be traveling to Nationals in Minnesota.

Highlights of the season include ShoulderCheck being well received by our hockey community and visiting teams. Frank's Fund was a big success! The Girls' Jamboree, goalie clinics and all the banners the teams brought home were other highlights for the season.

**Registrar's Report – Nancy Fenn** - Registration numbers predicted to be about the same next season. Next week, Nancy will start focusing on the calendar, coaches and team planning for the 2026-2027 season already. Nancy reminded the board that we are the organization hosting IAHA state next weekend and all board members are expected to participate and represent SVYH well. Hosting the State Tournament here saves our local families an estimated \$60K in travel costs!

Over \$9,000 was raised for the Scholarship Fund! Nancy asked the board to vote on the Scholarship Awards for the end of the season celebration next week. SVYH is now an official partner with Together We, the new local nonprofit leading the mental health initiative. The End of Season survey will be sent out next week. This year marks SVYH's 50th anniversary! The board will work on plans for celebrating.

**Hailey Ice – Sarah Benson** - Hailey Ice is home for the IAHA state tourney, will have sweatshirts here. Sarah asks everyone here to help be an ambassador if they see things at either rink. Please speak up. should be a very fun weekend. Sunday games may not be necessary since most divisions are only between 2 teams. Sarah talked about the proposed addition and explained how the new spaces will work and who they help accommodate. Suns have games next weekend. Val is coming back for spring, a lot of good camps so the rink will be open again this weekend.

**Community Safety Coordinator Report - Annie Leady** Annie working on getting emergency personnel available at the rink this weekend as volunteers. She will be setting up tables for the Shoulder Check program. Sun Valley Fire will do the same at the Sun Valley rink. Stop the bleed kits were delivered to the rink - locations in the rink and mounting are being worked out. Annie has an idea for a point person to help if there are any concerns for mental health that need to be addressed.

**Treasurer's Report – Barton Burdette** Barton sent a report last night that shows the season up to date which includes almost all revenue for the year. This should give a very good picture of how we are for revenue for the season. Went through and explained some of the line items in the budget. Revenue is done but we still have expenses to finish the season so this will be the best the budget looks. Brooke mentioned she would like to consider adding the budget for a skating and skills coach for next year.

**President's Report– Brooke McKenna** - At the end of season celebration next tuesday Brooke will announce the board Treasurer position which is open for applications. The April meeting will have an executive session.
