

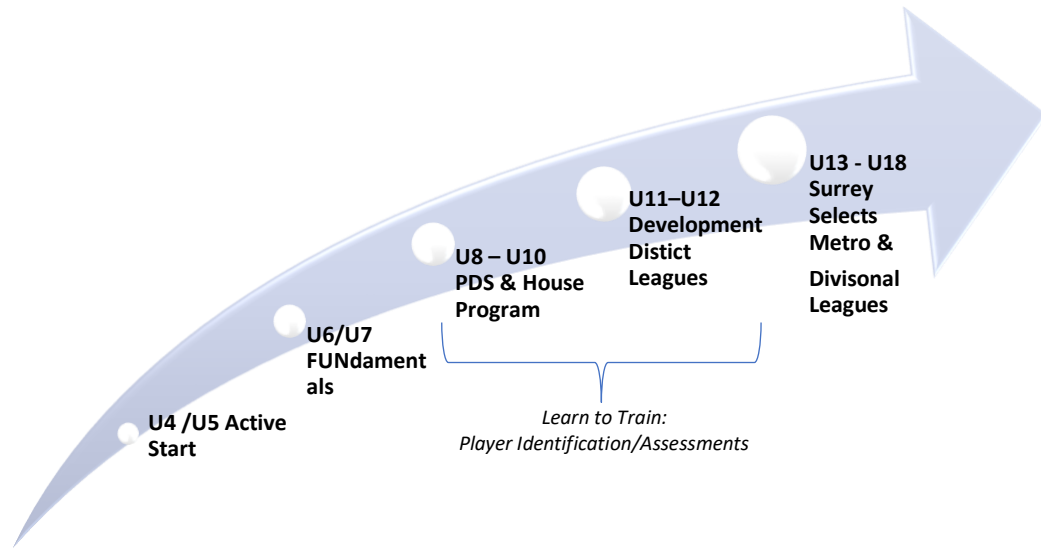

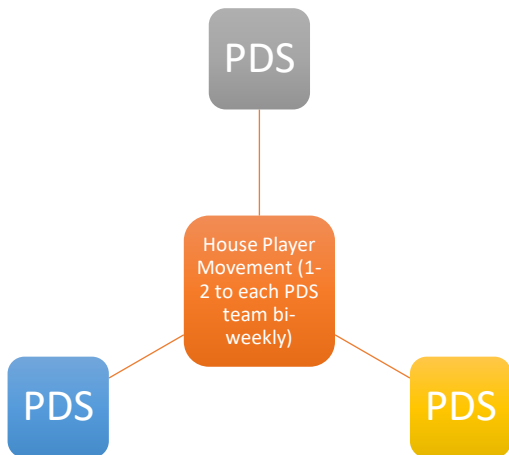

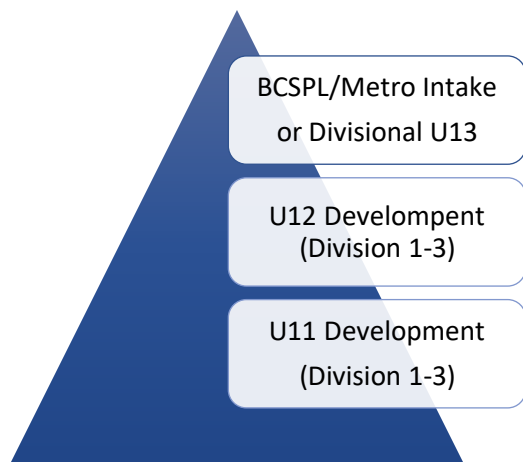


This program will have the PDS teams with smaller rosters, where there is opportunity for house players to be pulled up to the PDS games by the club Technical Team. Players will have **on-going assessments** throughout season to ensure they are playing with like-minded players. As mentioned above, there will be 3-4 Balanced PDS teams, and an open amount of house teams at these ages. Player Identification assessments will be held in our Feb/March club evaluation period. These assessments will be to identify players, and not necessarily move them.

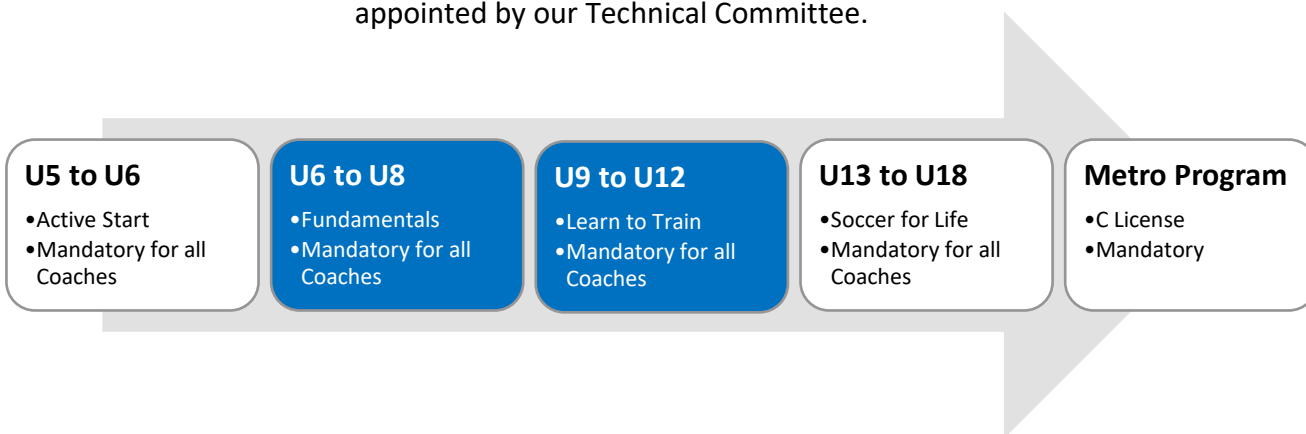
