The Prince George's County Boy and Girls Club is mandating the following guidelines as a foundation to limit possible exposure to COVID -19. We are highly recommending that all member clubs and PGCBGC participants review, and implement these foundational guidelines, as well as introduce more direct policies and procedures into your individual clubs and organizations.

Guidelines will change depending on the Sports and venues

Each team will be required to have the following:

- Properly Stocked First Aid Kit
- Hand Sanitizer

New Requirements

- All PGCBGC Volunteers will be required to wear face covering in public during all PGCBGC activities and events includes (practice, and games).
- Maintain the proper social distancing guidelines while engaging with players, spectators, and volunteers.
- Athletes, coaches, fans/spectators, and officiates should undergo screening using symptom checklists and temperature checks before each practice or competition.
- Will be required to post signage in highly visible areas promoting common protective measures including social distancing, requirement of face coverings, and frequent and adequate hand and respiratory hygiene practices.

Prohibiting Activities

- There will no longer be sharing of water bottles, towels, etc.
- No high fives, fist bumps or chest bumps.
