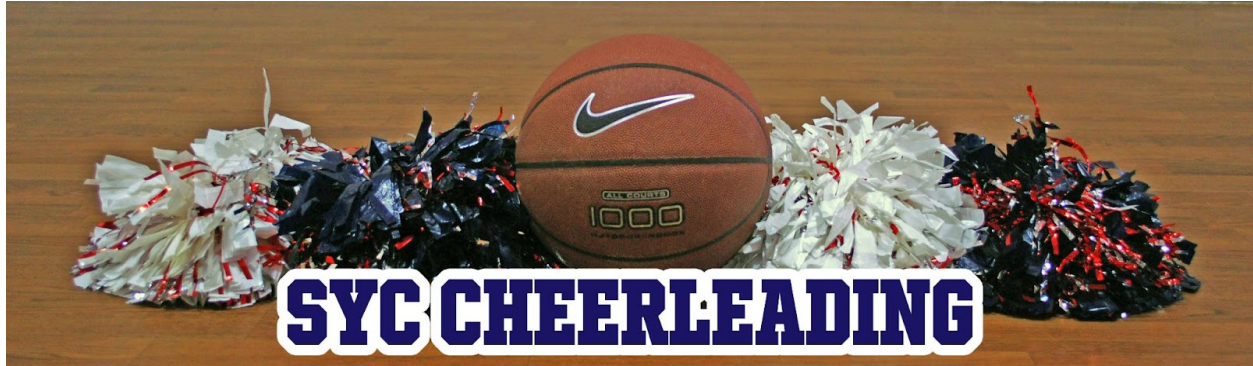

### **SYC is seeking cheerleading coaches for the 2022/23 Winter Season!**

No experience necessary! We will provide training sessions on how to teach cheers and run practices and games. There are two types of coaching positions available:

- **Head coach** [Adults only] - this person will handle email communications and general organization for the team. They will help assistant coaches when needed.
- **Assistant coach** [Adults or high/middle school students] - this person (or people) will teach cheers and lead practices and games. They will also make a cheer routine for our end of season exhibition.

Coaching is a volunteer position - this is a great way for students to earn volunteer hours and gain valuable leadership experience! Adults will receive credit that can be used for any SYC sport.

SYC cheerleaders cheer for SYC basketball games during the winter. Cheer squads are assigned to a time and location that will remain consistent week-to-week (Saturday mornings, school gyms in the Springfield area). Games last approximately an hour. The season runs from December to early March.
