BEDROCKERS SWEEP PALS 6-5 AND 18-4

THIS WEEKS PLAY.

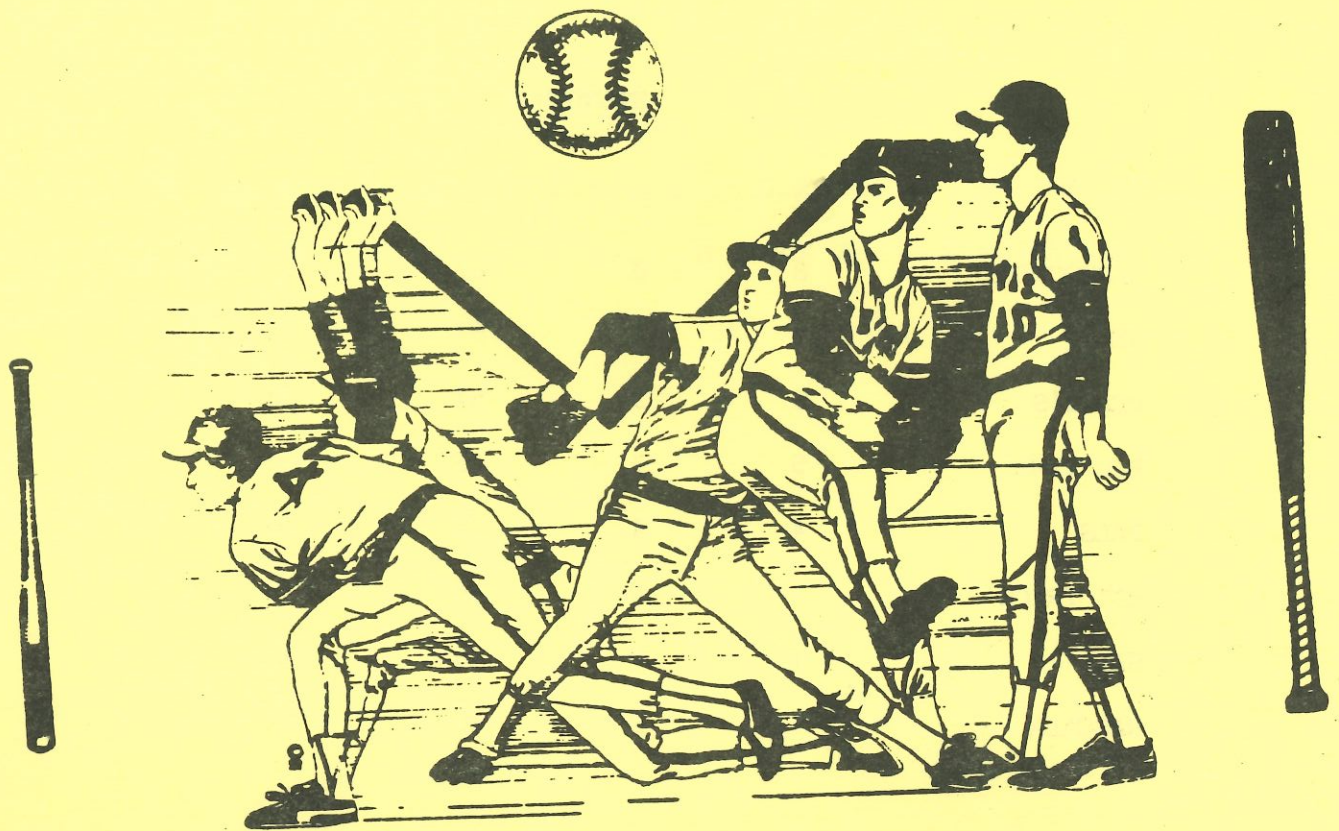
