2. Approve April 2023 Minutes - L.Doko Nathan Kanning (Sandpoint) made the 1st motion to approve; Natalie Gray (CdA HS) made 2nd motion to approve; all teams present voted unanimously on approving the April meeting minutes.

- **Regional Playoff / Seeding**
 - East - A. Herdt Seeding to be based on regular season standings
 - North - N. Kanning Regional playoffs being held to determine seeding in the North; Moscow has opted to forfeit based on # of players and ending their season pre-regional playoffs. Remaining five teams will participate in North regional playoffs (CHS, ICA, Lake City HS, Logos and Sandpoint HS)

Membership discussed having a uniform approach to seeding for the 2024 season to better represent equality across IHSLL. Clubs were advised to finalize rosters and submit any changes to the IHSLL board.

Opportunity to move Fri May 19 playoff games from Great Northern Sports Complex (multiple grass fields) to Memorial Field (single turf field). Game times at Memorial Field adjusted to 10am, 1pm, 4pm and 7pm PST (extended day vs original plan of two games played concurrently at 11am and 3pm PST.) Majority of IHSLL membership voted in favor of switching from grass fields to the turf field on Friday, May 19 with times as presented.
