

How to Register for an SSA Referee Course

1. All participants must submit a paper registration through a Scarborough Club.
2. You will not be approved unless SSA has your paper application and payment, or your club has it to submit to SSA.
3. Next you register on-line, which the Club will tell you how to do.
4. All Participants must attend ALL 3 dates for Entry Level or all day for Small Sided. NO EXCEPTIONS!
5. AGE must be 14 by March 31st, of year attending for Entry Level
6. Small Sided must be 12 by March 31st, of year attending.
7. Must be entered online 10 days before the course starts.
8. No refunds will be given 15 days before the course starts.

What is required of the participants in order to complete the Entry Level Clinic

1. Register for course via RefCentre E2E.
2. Complete the precourse workbook on RefCentre E2E.
3. Attend the entire course (16 hours)
4. Complete in Class Workbook during the Clinic. Bring hard copy to class.
5. Complete the feedback survey after the course.
6. Pass the online Entry level Referee Examination within 48 hours of completing The course. -
7. Pick up your badge in the SSA Office shortly after course.

What is required of participants in order to complete the Small Sided course.

1. This course is now open to all ages over 12.
2. You must register online at RefCentre E2E.
3. You must attend the entire full day course.

Dates
