Overview

The chosen candidate(s) will work under the guidance of the club's Technical Director.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Plan and deliver the technical and tactical coaching program (practice sessions). (3 sessions per week)
- Conduct match preparation meetings and analysis with the team
- Coach and travel with the team to all competitions
- Utilize coaching resources and software to plan and manage training sessions and game play (KUSC will provide access to video analysis, academy soccer coach, and TeamSnap)
- Establish a periodized season plan aligned with the technical direction of the club and in keeping with OPDL requirements
- Prepare player evaluations as requested by Ontario Soccer (2 per season)
- Conduct Individual Development Plan Player Meetings (3 per season)
