## BASEBALL NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR

### NOTES

1. The Baseball NL representative will be appointed by Eastern Director Leon Ledgister. The Umpire Supervisor will be appointed by Umpire-In-Chief Mark Jones
2. Games will be scheduled for Monday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> if necessary due to rain.
3. Home team for all round robin games will be decided by a coin flip. Home team for the final and/or tiebreaker will be the higher-seeded team.
4. All players will be on a pitch count as per Baseball Canada pitch count guidelines for **their age.**
5. A ten (10) run mercy rule shall be in effect after five (5) innings of play, as well as a fifteen (15) run mercy rule after four (4) innings of play.
6. Please consult the 2024 Baseball NL Handbook for all tournament regulations. The handbook can be downloaded from the Baseball NL website.
7. If one team finishes the round robin with a 3-0 record and the other teams finish at 1-2, the 1-2 team with the least number of runs allowed per defensive inning (in games among the tied teams ONLY) will play the 3-0 team in a single championship game.

If three teams finish at 2-1, then the team which allows the least number of runs per defensive inning (in games among the tied teams ONLY) receives a bye to the final and the other two teams will play a tie-breaker game. A single championship game will follow. **This is the only scenario where a tie-breaker game will be played.**

**NOTE:** Least number of runs allowed per defensive inning is calculated by taking the total number of runs allowed and dividing it by the total number of defensive innings played, including any partial innings played.
