DC State Athletic Association Names Winter All-State Teams

Washington, DC – The District of Columbia State Athletic Association is proud to announce the selection of its Winter All-State teams. The teams were selected by coaches in each sport through majority vote.

COACH OF THE YEAR

Monique Liddell, Girls Varsity Head Coach, Maret School

Monique Liddell is a native of Sacramento, California and she played college basketball at Morgan State University. She finished her career among the program's all-time leaders for scoring, rebounds, and steals, and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2015. Prior to coaching at Maret, Liddell was the head coach at Mercersburg Academy, where her team won a conference championship in 2009. Currently, in her 8th year at Maret, Coach Liddell's Frogs won an ISL A championship in 2010, and then again in 2019 after surviving the 2018 campaign with a total of six players in the program.

Eric Singletary, Boys Varsity Head Coach, Sidwell Friends

Eric Singletary '93 has been head coach of the boys' varsity basketball team since 2008. Following his high school career, he was a four-year letterman at Rice University and played basketball professionally in Germany, Portugal, and stateside in the International Basketball League. During Coach Singletary's tenure, the team has shared five Mid-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAC) Championships, including a precedent-setting win as 2016 MAC co-champions of the regular season and MAC tournament winners. Currently in his 11th year at Sidwell Friends, Coach Singletary and his team won the 2019 District of Columbia State Athletic Association Class AA Basketball State Championship.
