



Varsity Softball Lettering Policy

The purpose of our varsity lettering policy is to recognize the commitment, work ethic and positive attitude demonstrated by our student-athletes throughout the short softball season. We believe in rewarding players who show up, work hard, support their teammates and represent our program well. Earning a varsity letter is both a privilege and a reflection of the standards upheld within our program.

To be eligible for a varsity softball letter, athletes must meet the following criteria:

1. Consistent Effort and Positive Attitude

Athletes are expected to attend practices and games with a strong work ethic, a willingness to improve and a positive, team-first attitude. We value effort, hustle and a positive attitude. Athletes who give their best at every practice and game, encourage their teammates and embrace their role will be recognized.

2. Finish What You Start

Athletes must finish the season as a member of the team in good standing. Voluntarily quitting or being removed from the team for disciplinary reasons will forfeit lettering eligibility. Being a part of this program means seeing it through – showing grit, resilience and commitment.

3. Prioritize Your Team

Athletes must prioritize team activities, including practices and games. Absences for non-emergent reasons – such as vacations, concerts and other voluntary personal commitments – will disqualify a player from earning a varsity letter. Life happens and true emergencies will be handled with care and understanding by the coaching staff.

Note: Playing time is not a factor in earning a varsity letter - it's about how you show up for your teammates, how you carry yourself in the face of challenges and how you contribute to the heart of this program. We want every athlete to walk away from the season better than they came. This policy is designated to reward the dedication, accountability and being a positive influence within our softball program.
