Meeting Minutes 5/16/17

1. Minutes: Rochelle made a motion to accept the minutes from 4/24/17. Sue C. seconded. Motion passed.
2. Director's Report: The marching band season starts tomorrow, 5/17. A student teacher who will be officially starting in the fall would like to be present during the marching band season as well. Band concert is on Monday, 5/22.
3. Treasurer's Report: Rochelle-We have \$39,200.72 in our account which is divided up into the categories of marching band, band trips, scholarships, general fund. We are at -\$6.00 for the pillows; after selling one more we will receive 100% profit from any more sold. We are at -\$530 for cost of tumblers but expect to sell many more. Other expenses include bins for uniforms and a mixer for \$100.
4. Fundraiser Report:
 - a. Bachman's Flowers: Beth-This was a successful fundraiser with a profit of \$3500 after selling 348 flowers. Beth mentioned the possibility of looking into other places to order flowers from in the future.
 - b. Parent Meeting Sales: Sue C.-Items were sold at the band parent meeting but profit made hasn't been tallied yet.
 - c. Tiger Scramble: Dan-1. Raffle-we will need to apply for a \$100 permit to allow us to do a raffle due to the fact that we do not have a gambling license. 2. Gale will be creating a signup genius for volunteers. 3. Flyers/sponsorships-Section leaders will receive a list of businesses to solicit sponsorships from. They will be given a specific script to use. 4. Budget-Dan requested an increase up to \$3100 to include the cost for golfer gifts, food, sponsor signs, and exempt gambling permit. Sue D. made a motion to change the Tiger Scramble budget from \$2500 to \$3100. Rochelle seconded. Motion passed. 5. With the help of Bill and Ben we have a sponsor online google form so businesses are able to choose their sponsorship level. 6. There was some talk about getting a car to have at the scramble for a "hole in one" prize. This would have to include an insurance policy. Dan will be looking into that.
 - d. Apparel: Purchase of Farmington band apparel can be done at Dakota Logo. A certain percent of purchases goes back to the band.

- f. Stadium Seats: We discussed whether we wanted to continue this fundraiser. After looking at the profit margin, and other factors, it was decided to allow this fundraiser to be available for other groups.
5. Uniforms: Rochelle-We are in the process of getting all parts of the uniforms organized and labeled. Volunteers will be coming in to steam the pants and students will be fitted for their uniforms during finals.
6. Marching Band updates:
 - a. Props-Dean met with Brad to get some ideas going. They will be meeting with the drill writer to continue planning.
 - b. Band Camp-Meals planned for band camp include Chipotle, Subway, Wengs, picnic and one other TBD.
 - c. Volunteer needs-Heidi will thinking about what needs we have.
7. Tiger Fan Club Report: Sue D.-Any booster within TFC wanting to hold a fundraiser needs to submit a request to be approved in order to avoid many boosters selling the same item or holding the same fundraiser.
8. Other: 1. Sue C. mentioned the possibility of working Ramble Jam. It was agreed to pass on this idea for now and focus more on the Tiger Scramble. 2. To solve the issue with the Farmington band website and e-mail being different with farmingtontigerbands vs. farming-tontigerband we will be purchasing another domain.
