PERFORMER & REGISTRATION FEES

Registration Deadline: **Sunday, April 26, 2026** No Exceptions.
Registrations must be received by deadline date – **ONLINE REGISTRATION ONLY.**

Soloist/Duet/Group Registration Fee: \$20

*Only **one** entry fee due for each solo, duet and/or group number and registration must be completed online. No splitting of payment is permitted. One duet/group member pays fee and all others are required to register at \$0 to complete registration and waiver. Duet/Group participants must be listed in the comments as well as name of the individual paying for the entry.*

Skaters are **limited to a total of two performances.**
Synchro is considered extra and does not count towards skater total.

Optional Warm Up Practice Ice Fee: \$15

***The event does not schedule any additional warm-up time. This will be the only time to skate prior to performance.*

ALL PERFORMER & PRACTICE ICE REGISTRATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED ONLINE

The Administration Office will not accept in-person registrations.

EXHIBITION POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Refund requests will only be considered in the event of an injury. All requests must be submitted in writing to Tara Patterson, Sr. Director of Skating & Programming via e-mail: tpatterson@coyotesice.com. Refund requests must be submitted within seven days of the injury and must be accompanied by a physician's statement indicating the nature of the injury and the length of recovery. Please Note: performance entries are booked on a first-come, first-served basis. In the event the exhibition is sold out and cannot accommodate your registration a refund will be issued.

COSTUMES

Please wear attire appropriate for your music selection such as a skating dress with beige tights or skating pants and a shirt that is respectable and appropriate for athletic performance (no crop tops, hoodies, etc.) Artistic costumes are acceptable. Long hair should be pulled back in a ponytail or bun. No bobby pins allowed.

Aspire 1 – Pre Juvenile: 1:30 max
Juvenile & Up: 2:00 mins max

***Competition/artistic program lengths will be honored.*

PHOTOGRAPHY + VIDEO

For the safety of all skaters no flash photography permitted.
