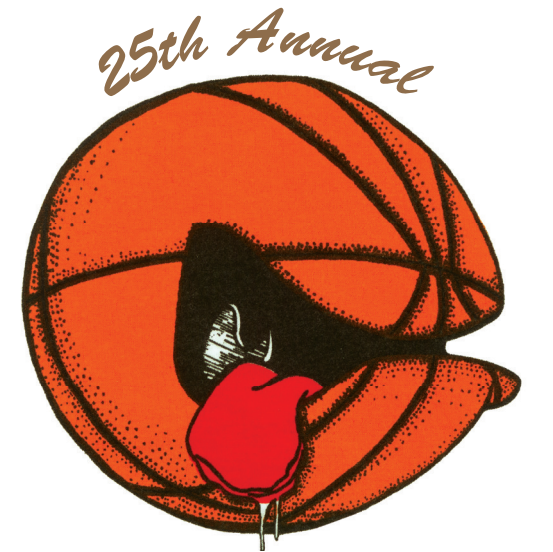

As Purple & Gold enters its 24th year, be sure that your son or daughter is a part of the Triangle's fastest growing and most complete basketball camp. This camp is like no other basketball camp of its kind because of the gifted staff and their ability to teach and to serve each camper's needs. The fundamentals of the game are stressed, especially the importance of playing man-to-man defense, and playing as a team. Our hope is that you will give our camp a try and see just how exciting Purple & Gold Basketball Camp really is. If you are not satisfied with the quality of this camp, your camp fee (minus the non-refundable deposit after May 1) will be returned to you.

DETAILS FOR 2019

Camp will begin each day at 9:00 AM and end at 3:00 PM. Each camper will receive a confirmation letter within 2 weeks of our receipt of your application and deposit. This letter will include more detailed information concerning concessions, lunches, and medical information. PLEASE READ THIS CONFIRMATION LETTER CAREFULLY.

Keep in mind that space is limited. We will only accept 100 campers for each session. In order to give as many kids as possible the opportunity to experience our camps, we are again offering 3 full-day sessions this year. The age range each week is smaller in order to place more kids of similar ages together at once. The ages for each session are as follows:



SESSION	DATE	BOYS
SESSION I	JUNE 17 - 21	AGES 10 -16 YEARS
SESSION II	JUNE 24 - 28	AGES 8 -12 YEARS
SESSION III	JULY 8 -12	AGES 10 -12 YEARS

This camp is very extensive and includes the fundamentals of playing 2-on-2, 3-on-3, 4-on-4 and 5-on-5. The team concept of basketball is emphasized. Film sessions are included.

The camp emphasizes individual skills (dribbling, passing and shooting) and teaches man-to-man defense. The player-to-coach ratio is low (less than 10:1). The enjoyment of the game is stressed. The camp includes skills competitions.
