 - Policy Title: MYH Financial Aid Program
 - Effective Date: April 2019

 - Purpose: Provide Financial assistance for those in need to pay for hockey fees

 - Persons Affected: members in financial need

 - Policy
- I. Criteria for Award
 - a. Applicants and the MYH Board will follow a consistent procedure in which the MYH Board will determine financial need of the requesting party to the best of their ability and award an amount accordingly.
 - II. Process
 - a. Applicants will check a box on the annual MYH Registration form to denote interest in financial aid or may request funds at any time.
 - b. The Board will accept rolling requests via applications throughout the season.
 - c. Interested parties will complete a “statement of need” letter that includes the specific amount of financial aid funds requested and will submit it to the club president for review.
 - d. The president, vice-president, and treasurer will review all applications and “statement of need” letters and present a summary of the applications to the Board at the next scheduled meeting.
 - i.
 - e. By a Board vote, the applicants will be granted financial aid funds.
 - III. Award Process
 - a. Applicants will be notified in a timely fashion of the Board’s decision.
 - b. The Board reserves the right to adjust the original monetary amount requested by the applicant as the Board deems fit.
 - c. For every \$100 in financial aid money awarded, the recipient family may be asked to donate an additional hour of volunteerism for the club, in addition to that already required.
 - d. If the additional volunteer requirements are not met, the recipient will not be allowed to apply for additional financial aid monies until such requirements are fulfilled.

- e. Waiver of the additional volunteer hours may be granted in the case of the recipient serving as the team rep or if the family has demonstrated a significant level of volunteer commitment with MYH.
- f. The skater may fulfill additional volunteer commitment for financial aid families, if the skater is at the Bantam or Midget level.
