3. All applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee which will determine who will be awarded scholarships and the dollar amount to be awarded. All applications will be reviewed thoroughly and awards will be determined after assessing the needs and situations of all applications presented.
4. Application Deadline is September 1, 2020.
5. Recipients will be notified by the Treasurer.

The amount and number of scholarships awarded is on an annual basis. Amounts awarded may also change from year to year. Individual scholarships are determined on an annual basis and must be applied for each year.
