The NAHS Boys Basketball Program consists of three teams of approximately 12 players each: Ninth Grade, Junior Varsity (JV), and Varsity. Students must try out to be considered for any of the teams.

- Try outs for all teams is **October 21st, 2019, in the NAHS gym.**
 - **6:00am Varsity try outs**
 - **4:00pm JV and Ninth Grade try outs**
 - Rosters will be announced on the website <https://www.nahswarriors.org/> later that evening.
- In order to try out, boys must upload a current physical here <https://northatlantawarriors-ga.e-pe.com/index.jspa>. You must create an account prior to uploading the physical.
- A hard copy of the physical and this signed form, must be brought to try outs in order to try out.

Students selected to play on any of the three teams need to plan for the following:

- **The player athletic contribution is \$450 per player for the season.**
 - This includes warm ups, shooting shirts, bookbags, as well as other items to support the program.
 - The payment is due Friday, October 25th, and will payable online, link TBD.
- Mandatory Parent Meetings will be in Coach Sarden's classroom in the gym, H3095
 - Varsity and JV, October 23rd, 6:00pm
 - Ninth Grade, October 24th, 6:00pm
- The varsity team is scheduled to play in a tournament in Chattanooga December 19th through December 21st. All players are to attend. Players should bring meal money for the three days.

In order to sustain a successful basketball program, support from all players and families is necessary.

The following activities will be requested of families of team members:

- Provide a game meal on week day game days. Each family will be assigned a date. Families can provide a meal themselves or pay a fee (tbd) and a meal will be provided on their assigned date.
- Work assigned dates and times in the concession stand. Boys' families work the girl's games.
- Volunteer to support the overall program-social media, player of the week, organize concessions, etc.
- Team members volunteer at off-season basketball activities and fundraisers
