

## Tri-City Storm (USHL) Goaltender Selection Camp: Fact Sheet June 15<sup>th</sup> and June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021

The Tri-City Storm Goaltender Selection Camp will be held June 15th and 16th, 2021.

The camp will be held at the Las Vegas Ice Center: 9295 West Flamingo Road #130 Las Vegas, NV 89147.

These tryouts are open to any eligible goaltender age 16-20 years (2005-2001) not currently on another USHL team's protected list.

There is a \$300.00 Goaltender Selection Camp Registration Fee. Since there is no cost for playing for the Storm, this is the only fee for the season if a player makes the team.

The camp format includes many different on-ice drills with junior, college, and pro caliber shooters. The camp is overseen by Tri-City Storm Goaltending Coach Matt Zaba and the Storm USHL Coaching Staff.

Select goaltenders that perform well from this camp will continue to the next phase of the Storm Final Selection Camp on Thursday and Friday and will be again re-evaluated for participation Friday evening and Saturday for the club's two All-Star Games. The top goaltenders at the Storm Goaltender Selection Camp should prepare to spend the full five days in Las Vegas, Nevada.

There will be no additional Registration Fee after the first payment if a goaltender advances to the next portions of the Tri-City Storm Selection Camp after the first two days.

The Tri-City Storm will carry two or three goalies on their active roster for 2021-2022. The Storm will also use this camp to evaluate goaltenders for future USHL Drafts.

This camp is also a great opportunity for players who may not think they are quite ready for the USHL level yet want to experience an extremely competitive camp, become familiar with one of the top developmental programs in the country, meet the Storm hockey staff, and show their potential for following season(s).

Various NCAA Division I teams and NAHL clubs will be in attendance at the Final / Main Camp beginning June 17th for maximum exposure to attending players.

It is advised that goaltenders come in top physical condition in order to perform well in this competition. The five days will be very grueling and tiring.

Participating goaltenders will receive a detailed schedule via email at least one week prior to the camp.

The camp facility and host hotel will meet all necessary state and government safety requirements necessary.

If the camp dates must be cancelled or changed on behalf of the team – full refunds of the registration fees for the camp will be provided.
