- **Coaches**
 - Head Coach Andrew Weiers, Assistant Josh Fish, Volunteer Nate Plagge
- **Communication**
 - All communication is through **Remind 101!** Text @shakopeeb to 81010 or go rmd.at/shakopeeb to sign up (link can be found on our website)
 - HS Golf Web page is best spot to check for updates (subscribe to google calendar)
 - Twitter, Facebook, and Occasional emails will be sent as well
- **Teams**
 - Varsity/JV: This can shuffle throughout the year based on current play and schedule. Usually top 12-16 players
 - Developmental Team:
 - Practice 2-3 days a week based on schedule and facilities
 - Inter squad matches at WE's
 - End of the season Event vs another team
 - (Potential for other meets throughout the season, but nothing guaranteed)
 - Potential Player Cuts due to numbers, space, staffing and budget
- **Transportation to Meets**
 - Due to bus driver shortages, athletes will be required to get themselves to meets throughout the season
 - There will be a transportation waiver that will be filled out that will cover the entire season
- **Tryouts**
 - Qualifying Rounds
 - Players will qualify on course at WE's to show they can keep up with pace of play before getting a qualifying round at Stonebrooke (unless otherwise proven in a past season)
 - Our goal is to have 3 qualifying 9 hole rounds at Stonebrooke
 - Scores will be kept by another player, if cheating is identified you will not make the team
 - Rules Test
 - There will be a rules test during tryouts. Not knowing the rules can cost you strokes and even get your score thrown out. It is imperative to know the rules of golf to be a competitive golfer.
 - Swing analysis
 - This will be done on each player. Analysis will take into account swing path, fluidity of swing, ball contact, ball flight, and consistency.
 - Scorecard Consistency Chart
 - Consistency chart will be put together based on qualifying rounds scorecards showing clusters of scores based on score compared to par.
 - There will be constant communication and feedback with player throughout this process. Not all players may be required to complete all 3 rounds based on exceeding requirements in other areas or past performance. Cuts may also be made early

depending on weather and scheduling. Cuts will also factor in progress made in the program and projection in future.

- Week 1: March 20th- 24th
 - Tryouts take place (AM in field house if course not open)
- Week 2: March 27th-30th
 - Finish Tryouts, normal practice (AM in field house if course not open)
- Week 3 (Spring Break) April 3th-7th
 - Practice TBD based on who is around, Golf trip is excused absence
- **Practice**
 - Practices are at Water's Edge from 3:30-5:00
 - Practices may go later or be relocated to accommodate practice rounds
 - We will work with student athletes on alternative times for practice due to academic conflicts (especially with missing school)
 - In your bag you need
 - Clean Golf Clubs
 - Marked golf balls
 - Tee/Markers/Divot tool
 - Rain Gear
 - Alignment Sticks
 - Rangefinder/yardage sheet
 - Rules Book/Cheat sheet
- **Uniform**
 - White Titleist hat (provided by Booster Club). Extras will be \$25 a piece
 - White Nike Polo: Provided by AD's office. Keep from year to year, replaced if you need a new size
 - Shakopee ¼ Zip from Team Store
 - Optional Alternative Polo and Long Sleeve items offered in online store
 - Black Pants (shorts optional)
 - Golf Shoes
 - Team color golf belt
 - Rain Gear/umbrella
- **Lettering**
 - A Varsity Letter will be earned by one of the following
 - Compete in 50% or more of Varsity events
 - Be in the line-up on a team qualifying for day 2 of Sections
 - Graduate from the program after 2 or more years of participation
 - The coaching staff reserves the right to letter any athlete they see fit that does not meet above situations.
